“AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATE OF TAXATION FOR THE YEAR 2023 ON ALL MOTOR VEHICLES AND LEVYING SAID TAX FOR ALL CITY PURPOSES”. Summary: This ordinance fixes the rate of taxation for the year 2023 at the sum of twenty-two and seven tenths cents (22.7 cents) on each one hundred dollars (\$100) valuation on all motor vehicles subject to taxation in the City.

Summary: That the 2022 City of Frankfort ad valorem tax rate is Nineteen and Three Tenths Cents (19.3 cents) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) valuation of all real and personal property; Nineteen and Three Tenths Cents (19.3 cents) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) valuation on public utilities and public service companies taxable on a franchise basis.
