YARD WASTE



Yard waste, such as clippings of grass, flowers, shrubs and hedges, as well as brush, weeds and leaves (except during loose leaf collection season), must be placed into brown paper yard waste bags, or into 32 gallon heavy-duty garbage/refuse containers labeled "Yard Waste". Yard waste must be at the curb by 7:00 am on your scheduled trash day.



Tree trunks, limbs and branches must be no longer than 6 feet in length and must be placed to the curb cut ends facing the street, in piles no higher than 3 feet high & 10 feet wide. Tree trunks can be placed to the curbside in cut pieces not weighing more than 50 pounds and a maximum of 8" in diameter. There can be no other forms of debris included with the yard waste. All yard waste must be placed at the curb apart from household refuse set out for collection



Holiday Tree Collection: Holiday trees are collected in December and January and must be placed at the curb as yard waste. All decorations (including tinsel), nails and metal stands must be removed.

LOOSE-LEAF COLLECTION

Loose leaves are collected from October 1 - December 31 with a leaf vacuum machine and taken to a composting facility. Please follow these rules:

- Rake leaves to the curb or to the sidewalk, if you have one.
- Keep leaves free of debris and litter.
- Do NOT rake large branches, rocks, litter or animal waste into leaf piles. Large sticks and rocks can damage vacuum equipment, cause breakdowns, and injure employees.
- Do NOT rake leaves into the gutter, street, storm drains or drainage swales. (Acid from leaves is harmful to the local watershed).
- Do NOT park in front of leaf piles. Public Works will NOT remove leaves from behind or under parked cars.
- After December 31, loose leaves will be collected as yard waste.
