Mayor Wilkerson gave opening remarks and offered the background of the E-911 dispatch center. There has been a \$1.00 fee on landlines for approximately 30 years. Landlines are phasing out therefore E-911 is underfunded with revenue of \$116,000.00 and costs have increased between \$1.2 - \$1.4 million.

Franklin County Judge Executive Michael Mueller gave his opening remarks and looks forward to the community working together. This meeting is for informational purposes only and everyone will go back to discuss with each respective body.

Captain Wills representing the Franklin County Sheriff's Office gave a presentation.

Fire Chief Brewer representing the Franklin County Fire Department gave a presentation.

Police Chief Dustin Bowman and Fire Chief Jason Monroe representing the City of Frankfort spoke about the importance of dispatch and the lifesaving services we offer.

Ray Kinney, Director of Emergency Management, gave a brief history of dispatch, how it was combined years ago and the importance of having direct contact with dispatch at all times.

Franklin County Judge Executive Michael Mueller opened up for questions from the Magistrates and the Board of Commissioners.

It was moved by Commissioner Waldrige, seconded by Commissioner Unger, that the meeting adjourn. The question was put upon the motion and was adopted by voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 5:16 p.m.
