## WHAT IS RECYCLABLE?

When in doubt, throw it out!

### ACCEPTED CURBSIDE

### NOT ACCEPTED

#### PAPER & FOOD CARTONS

- Newspaper, magazines
- Office paper, junk mail, catalogs
- Milk, juice, and broth type boxes

- Brown paper bags

#### PLASTIC

- Any size screw top plastic bottle or jug (soft drink bottles, bleach jugs, laundry detergent jugs, milk jugs, etc.)

- Plastic grocery bags or film\*
- Plastic toys
- Plastic produce or food containers

#### PAPERBOARD & CARDBOARD

- Corrugated cardboard
- Paperboard (cracker/cereal boxes, toilet/paper towel rolls, shoe boxes, clean pizza boxes, etc.)

- Brown paper bags
- Refrigerated or frozen food boxes (may be dropped at Rouse Ave)
- Pizza boxes (greasy)

#### METAL

- Aerosol cans (hair spray, etc) - must be punctured
- Aluminum soda/beer cans
- Steel food cans

- Appliances (refrigerators, hot-water heaters, microwaves, etc.) These items may be placed at the curb on your regular collection day.

#### GLASS

- Glass bottles, all colors
- Glass jars, all colors

- Window glass or Mirrors
- Ceramics
- Light bulbs

## DROP OFF RECYCLING OPTIONS

### 309 Rouse Avenue:

- **Electronic/E-Scrap** - Please call 502-875-8527 prior to dropping off to confirm staff availability.
- All materials accepted in your recycle carts can be dropped off, 24-hrs per day, at the Recycling Center (309 Rouse Ave.)

### \*Kroger:

- **Plastic Grocery Bags and Plastic Films** - Available in both the east and west side stores. Look for the Zero Hunger/Zero Waste bins at the front of the store. They accept plastics such as bubble wrap, plastic overwrap, produce bags, and clean sandwich bags.
