 <p><b>✓ Metal Cans</b></p> <p>Recycle all food and beverage metal cans. Include steel, tin, bi-metal, and aluminum.</p>	<p><b>✓ DOs</b></p> <p>Please rinse all metal and plastic containers.</p> <p><b>✓ Cardboard</b></p> <p>Recycle all dry, corrugated cardboard.</p> 	 <p><b>✓ Plastics</b></p> <p>Recycle any size screw top plastic bottles or jugs with a number 1 or 2 inside the recycle arrows.</p>

## **✗ DON'Ts**

**✗ Paper** No envelopes, office or school papers, junk mail, greeting cards, file folders, or gift wrap paper. No newspaper or inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books, or brochures. No food boxes (juice boxes, egg or milk cartons, beverage boxes, and cereal or pasta boxes).



**✗ Plastic Bags, Plastic Items without Numbers**

No plastic shopping bags or plastic items without numbers in the recycle arrow (hangers, children's toys, etc.).

**✗ Glass** No glass of any color. No window glass, mirrors, or ceramics. No light bulbs.



**✗ Diapers, Tissues, or other Hazardous Materials**

**✗ Electronics**

No electronics, cables, or batteries. **Disposal for these items is available at the Recycle Center.**



**✗ Construction Debris or Yard Waste**

Do not place yard waste in plastic bags. The three options for yard waste disposal are a permanent container labeled "yard waste" (weighing no more than 50 pounds), biodegradable paper yard waste bags (available at area hardware, home improvement, and discount stores), or blue overflow bags.
