**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12, 2020 SERIES APPROPRIATING THE REVENUE
TO BE RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF FRANKFORT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021**
